In helping them prepare, please remember that **nothing containing nuts or sesame should be brought in** and they are only catering for a small number in their group. Please do not send them in with excess quantities which will only be thrown away. They should not bring in drinks nor anything which is valuable to decorate their table with. Key Stage 1 Christmas Party – Thursday:

If your child in in EYFS, Year 1 or Year 2 their Christmas party will be on Thursday. Please send your child in with £1 on Monday which the staff will collect before going off to buy party food. Their party falls on our Christmas jumper day so like everyone else they can come to school wearing a Christmas jumper as part of their party attire. This means they should not bring clothes to change into. Please be mindful of the fact that they will be in their party clothes for the whole day and out in them at break and lunchtime. Therefore, if they want to wear party shoes it would be sensible to send them in with an alternative pair to wear before their party starts.

Orders for Christmas lunch closed a while ago. If you have not placed an order, please be sure to send your child in with a packed lunch on Thursday as we are unable to cater for anyone who has not pre-booked. Thank you
